



## **RFTA Lost and Found Information**

Lost and Found is gathered on a nightly bases from all RFTA locations and brought to our Aspen Maintenance Facility – 51 Service Center Drive, Aspen – Across from the Aspen Airport next to the Animal Hospital.

### **Valuable or Personal Items (wallets, cell phones)**

Found on RFTA property or buses are logged into a spreadsheet that we keep forever. The item is tagged with the date found and we hold onto it for 21 days at Dispatch. After 21 days the item either goes to the Aspen Police Department or the Thrift Store. Dispatch is opened 24hrs/day 7 days a week.

Any items identified as related to the Aspen School District that have not been claimed within the 21 days, will be sent to the school district after that time.

### **Non Valuable Items – (jackets, gloves)**

We keep three bins of clothing in dispatch at the Aspen Maintenance Facility that people can come look through to find their items. These are also open 24/7. We are so overwhelmed with items during winter that we typically don't go looking through them for lost requests; individuals will need to come and look through the items themselves. These items are donated to charity after 21 days.
